



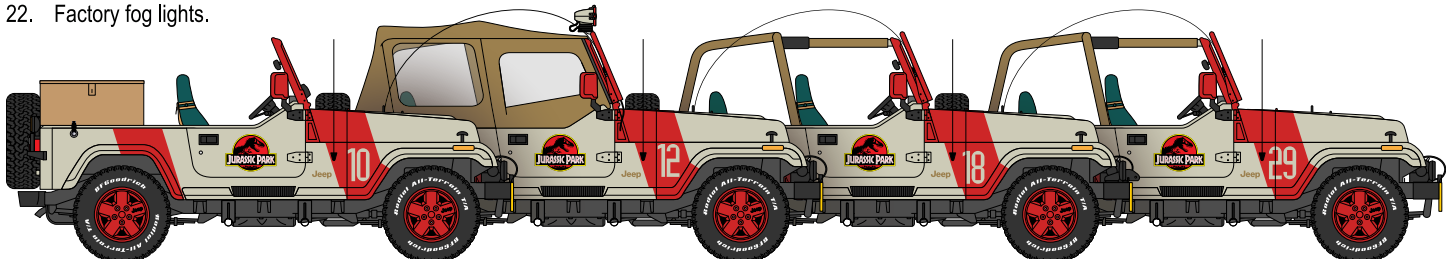

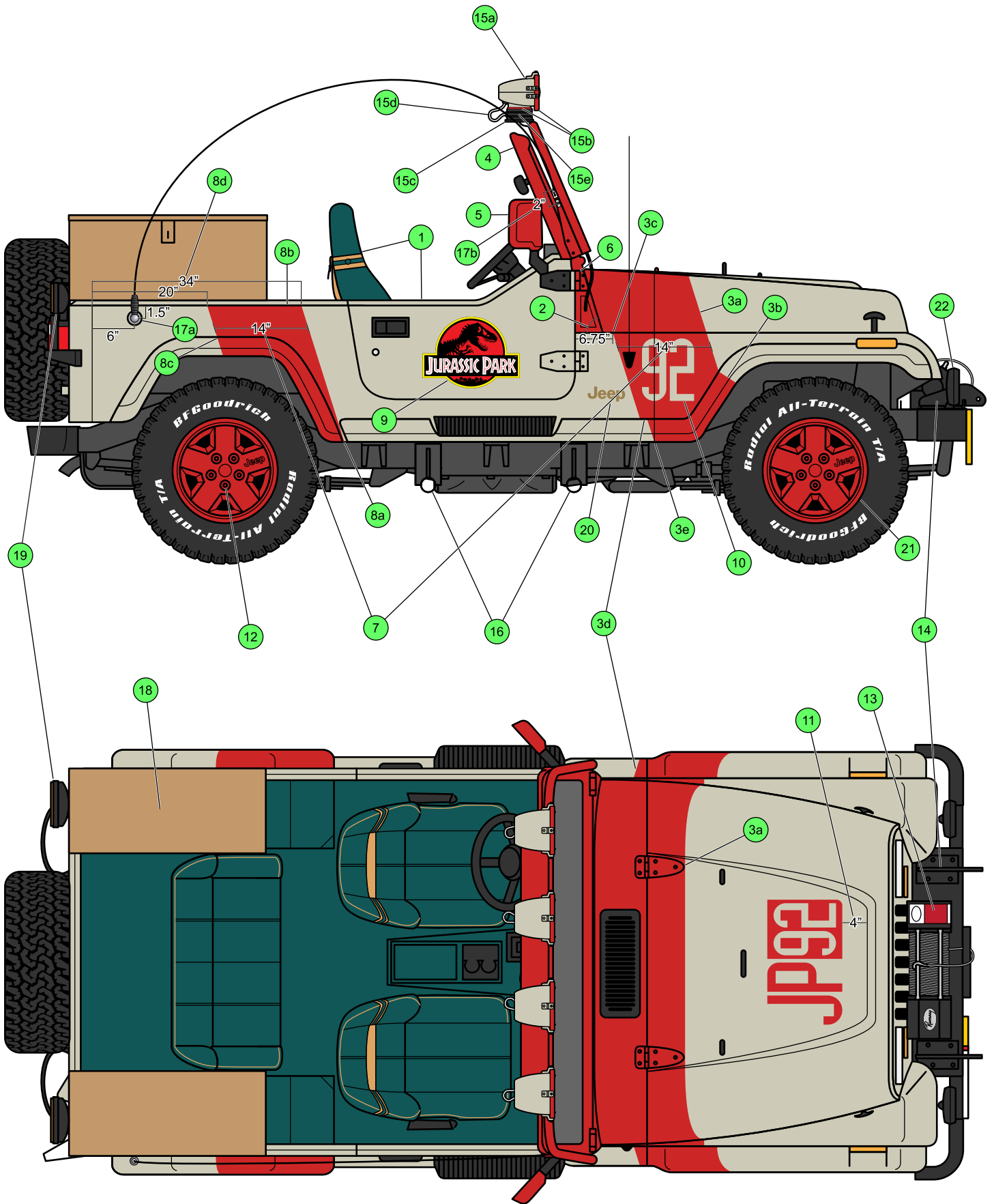

1. 1992 or 1993 Sahara interior with half doors.
2. Angle of stripes is derived from the angle of this seam (approx 73°).
- 3a. Front edge of forward stripe starts at front of hood hinges and begins to curve forward as it wraps around the side of the hood (appears as a straight line when viewed from the side).
- 3b. Front edge of forward stripe wraps around trim perpendicular (90°) to the rim angle.
- 3c. Rear edge of forward stripe follows seam approximately 6.75" back towards the door.
- 3d. Rear edge of forward stripe wraps around the trim at the corner and continues the fixed angle (see #2) on the horizontal portion of the flare, causing a disruption of the line when viewed from the side.
- 3e. Rear edge of forward stripe ends at seam between trim pieces.
4. Only the front of the windshield is painted red, not the back.
5. Mirror housing is painted right up to the mirror, itself (see "OBJECTS IN MIRROR" scene, 1:21:00).
6. Top barrel on the hinge (door side) is painted red.
7. Back stripe is the same width as the front stripe (approx 14").
- 8a. Front edge of back stripe passes through the gap between trim pieces.
- 8b. Back stripe does not extend under the soft top retaining channel.
- 8c. Rear edge of back stripe wraps around flare such that it creates an uninterrupted line when viewed from the side.
- 8d. Top front edge of back stripe is approx 34" from rear tub seam. Rear edge is approx 20" from seam.
9. "Jurassic Park" logo is 15.5" wide, centered horizontally below the middle upper half door mounting hole, and centered vertically between the retaining channel and lower edge of the door (approx 1.5" up from lower edge of door).
10. Side numbers are 10" tall, and placement varies from one Jeep to the next (see examples below, based on movie references).
11. Hood Logo goes 4" up from raised hood line. JPXX stamp is 12" tall x 20" wide (numbers are 10" tall), centered on hood.
12. Chrome lug nuts on driving wheels are painted, but the three chrome lug nuts holding the spare are unpainted.
13. Ramsey REP6000 winch, 251128 U-Channel 36" winch plate, and spacers.
14. Custom tow eyes.
- 15a. Upper housing of Jabsco lights and brackets are painted Sand Beige.
- 15b. Brush guard and ring that protrudes from the top of the Jabsco base are painted red.
- 15c. Lower section of Jabsco base is painted black.
- 15d. Decorative white cable connects the upper and lower sections of the Jabscos, connecting at each with a black grommet or tire stem valve.
- 15e. Three black rings of molding are added to the base of the Jabscos.
16. Camera Mount.
- 17a. Center of CB ball mount is 1.5" down the vertical portion of the exterior and 6" forward from the seam.
- 17b. 102" whip antenna is tied down with Kalibur K101X, with the mounting hole drilled 2" down from the top of the R side lightbar support bracket.
18. Knaack JOBMASTER 28 tool boxes.
19. POWER/DICK CEPEK C819S fog lights.
20. Spice soft top (clear windows), roll cage pads, "Jeep" logo, and "4.0L HIGH OUTPUT" (not pictured) decals.
21. 5 spoke "Jeep" wheels (not Sahara factory wheels) with BF Goodrich All-Terrain T/A KO(2) tires, size 235/75R 15.
22. Factory fog lights.
